

## **AFF Fly Tying Clinic with Tom Logan FFI - September 29, 2018**

Tom H. Logan is Director of Fly-fishing Adventures and a life member of the Fly Fishers International (FFI). Mr. Logan is a Certified Wildlife Biologist and published fly tier, has taught fly tying locally and at regional and international shows of FFI and is an FFI Certified Casting Instructor. He serves as Chairman of the Board of Directors, Senior Advisor on Conservation and Chairman of the Fly Tying Group Board of Governors of the FFI.

Tom had this to say about the patterns below:

“Most of all these have or are designed after patterns that have historic significance regarding applications in many parts of the world. They all offer techniques and material uses both for tying the indicated patterns and many other variations. My intent is that the patterns will provide variety of techniques and materials, be interesting and have applications to virtually any fly tying...”

Patterns are listed in alphabetical order and not the order Tom will tie.  
We will tie as many patterns as time allows.



### **Blue Olive Chickabou Streamer**

Hook: Daiichi 1550 or 4640, Size 14 – 10

Thread: Black Danville 6/0 or Veevus 8/0

Body: Two Paired White or Badger Whiting American Rooster Cape Feathers, Six Strands of Crystal Flash, One Olive and One Kingfisher Blue Whiting Chickabou Feathers with One Lemon Wood duck Flank.

Head: Black Thread (Bead Head Optional) and Sally Hansen Hard As Nails or Loon Hard-Head Clear for Finish



### **CDL Streamer**

Hook: Daiichi X472 or 2461, size 1/0 or Smaller

Thread: Danville's 6/0 Fly Master, Black

Wing: Two Matching Whiting Coq-de-Leon Rooster Hackles, 2X Length of Hook Shank

Body: Pearl Mylar Medium, Double Wrapped from Front and Return

Ribbing: Gold Wire, Counter Wrapped

Throat: Whiting Spey Hackles, Salmon, Five Hackles with Tips Matching to Hook Bend

Hackle: Two Blue-eared Pheasant Body Feathers, Wrapped Individually as Soft-hackles

Head: Black Thread, Build Head and Finished With “Hard as Nails” for Gloss



### **Deceiver**

Hook: Daiichi 472, Size 10 – 2/0

Thread : Black Danville's Fly-Master Waxed, 6/0 or 3/0

Body: Silver Mylar Tinsel, Medium with Wire Rib - Optional

Wing: Two Whiting Farms White or Grizzly Rooster Feathers, two strands of Crystal Flash Doubled, White and Chartreuse Buck Tail and Brown Buck Tail or Peacock Herl on Top

Head: Black Thread/Eyes optional/Head Cement



### **Partridge and Orange**

Hook: Daiichi 1550, Size 10-14

Thread: Black Danville 6/0 or Gudebrod 8/0, or Color to Match Floss

Abdomen: Orange Danville's 4 Strand Rayon Floss, or Other Color of Choice

Thorax : Absent, Peacock Herl, Fiery Brown SLF, or Other Similar Material

Hackle: Hungarian Partridge or Whiting Farms Hen Coq-de-Leon Saddle or Cape

Head: Black Thread or Color to Match Floss



### **Reverend Lang**

Hook: Daiichi 1110 in size 10-14

Thread: Yellow 6/0 or Gudebrod 8/0

Wing: White calf tail

Tail: White calf body hair

Body: Black, long-strand sculpin wool on hide

Hackle: Whiting Farms Coachman rooster saddle or cape



### **“Milk Gravy”**

Hook: Daiichi 1550, Size 14

Thread: Black Danville 6/0 or Gudebrod 8/0

Tail: Three Barbs from Bobwhite Quail Breast Feather

Body: Webbing Trimmed from Each Side of Bobwhite Quail Feather Shaft

Hackle: Bobwhite Quail Breast Feather

Head: Black Thread and Cement of Choice



## **Wacissa**

Hook: Daiichi 2340, size 10

Thread: Danville's 6/0 Flymaster, Black

Wing: Two Whiting Farms Coq-de-Leon Rooster Hackles, 2X Length of Hook Shank

Body: Medium Mylar Tinsel, Silver, Double Wrapped from Front and Return

Ribbing: Small Round Tinsel, Silver, 5 Counter Wraps

Hackle: Blue Rump Feather of Ring-necked Pheasant, Wrapped as Soft-hackle

Head: Black Thread Finished with Sally Hansen Hard as Nails for Glossy Finish



## **Western Coachman**

Hook: Daiichi 1550, #10-16

Thread: Black Danville's 6/0 or Gudebrod 8/0

Tail: Golden pheasant tippet

Body: Peacock herl with fine gold wire rib

Wing: White deer hair

Hackle: Coachman brown Indian rooster neck or Whiting coachman brown hen saddle

Head: Black thread
